Ceiling Fans

You should have a ceiling fan in each bathroom to move air outdoors via vents on the balcony ceiling. Please turn on the fan when you have a shower, to vent the moist air and lower the humidity. To clean the inside of the fan housing, once a year remove the fan cover and pass your vacuum cleaner nozzle inside. Clean the cover grate with an old toothbrush or something similar.
